Ground Rules:

Only the actual contestant and one companion allowed gate access.

Contestant's entrance & check-in is at the Southeast gate of the Stadium.

All Contestants must use designated parking.

Use 1-15 exit 344 to 12th Street, go east (right) to Monroe Blvd then turn right to Park Blvd.

CONTESTANT PARKING IS ON PARK BLVD ONLY. No animals allowed on any grass area.

- 1. Two go-rounds, back-to-back. The first go-round of each back-to-back group will run during slack each day. The contestants with the top ten fastest times from the first go-round will be placed in the performance (slowest time will run first, fastest time will run last). The number of contestants placed in the performance will not exceed ten. If splits result in more than ten, a random draw will determine which contestants will compete in the performance and which will compete in slack. The order of competition of ties from the first performance will also be determined by random draw. The remaining contestants not placed in the performance will run their second go round immediately following the completion of the first go round in reverse order of their first go position. The order of the draw will be the same as the competition order.
- 2. If a contestant (or team) qualifies for the finals at Namp on July 20 or at Salt Lake City on July 24 and is placed in the morning slack at Ogden on one of those days, he (they) will be allowed to compete on his (their) second go-round animal immediately following the completion of the first go-round as long as he (they) notifies the rodeo secretary prior to the stock draw for the second go-round. These contestants will compete first (and draw last) in the second go-round regardless of their first go-round times. The ten contestants with the fastest times, not including the contestants who qualified for the finals at Nampa or Salt Lake City and requested to be run first in the second go-round, will be placed in the performance following the procedures outlined in the previous rule.
